



# Resolution

Whereas Regional Council passed Resolution 2017-68 on February 9, 2017, on recommendation from the Community Water Fluoridation Committee, to request that the Province of Ontario both test for water toxicity due to the use of hydrofluorasilicic acid (HFSA) and take legislative responsibility for the regulation and administration of HFSA in water fluoridation treatments across the province;

And whereas, Regional Council passed Resolution 2017-185, on March 9, 2017, on recommendation from the Community Water Fluoridation Committee, to both reduce the concentration in Peel's lake-based municipal water supply, adjusting it to the lowest level in accordance with provincial standards for the prevention of tooth decay, and modify the fluoride additive used in the Region's water supply to reduce the levels of residual components;

And whereas, Resolution 2017-185 also suspended the Committee from meeting again until the Province had responded to the request contained with Resolution 2017-68;

Therefore be it resolved, that the requests for delegation related to community water fluoridation appearing on the Regional Council Agenda for March 30, 2017, and all further correspondence, communications, items and requests of any nature from any source on this matter, be referred to the Community Water Fluoridation Committee, when they reconvene, as per the Committee's process, for determination.
