(Riley Brandt/University of Calgary) Dialysis is the most common treatment for people with kidney failure worldwide. But the process, which involves hooking up patients at least three times a week to a machine that cleans their blood, can be painful, time-consuming, and sometimes ineffective.

For dialysis to occur, a physician must create entry to the bloodstream, called

vascular access. Researchers from the University of Calgary's Cumming School of Medicine reviewed different methods available to achieve the most effective


use of the vascular access. Results from this study were recently published in

the Cochrane Library.


