This is a formal request for access to general records, made under Alberta's *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy (FOIP) Act*.

I have sent payment of the application fee via mail to the address listed above, by cheque payable to the Government of Alberta.

### **Description of Requested Records:**

All studies and/or reports in the possession, custody or control of Premiere Kenney and/or his office/institution describing the **purification** (i.e. via via filtration, ultracentrifugation and chromatography) of any "COVID-19 virus" (aka "SARS-COV-2", **including any alleged "variants" i.e. "B.1.1.7", "B.1.351", "P.1")** directly from a sample taken from a diseased human, where the patient sample was not first combined with any other source of **genetic** material (i.e. monkey kidney cells aka Vero cells; fetal bovine serum).

Please note that I am **not** requesting studies/reports where researchers **failed to purify** the suspected "virus" and instead:

- cultured an unpurified sample or other unpurified substance, and/or
- performed an amplification test (i.e. a PCR test) on the total RNA from a patient sample or from a cell culture, or on genetic material from any unpurified substance, and/or
- fabricated a genome based on millions of sequences detected in the total RNA from a patient sample or from a cell culture or from any unpurified substance, and/or
- produced electron microscopy images of unpurified things in a cell culture.

#### Clarification of Request

For further clarity, please note I am already aware that according to virus theory a "virus" requires host cells in order to replicate, and I am **not** requesting records describing the **replication** of a "virus" without host cells.

Further, I am **not** requesting private patient information, or records that describe a suspected "virus" floating in a vacuum; I am simply requesting records that describe its **purification** (i.e. **separation** from everything else in the patient sample, as per standard laboratory practices for the purification of other very small things).

Please note that my request includes any study/report matching the above description, for example (but not limited to) any published peer-reviewed study **authored by anyone**, **anywhere**.



On August 17, 2021, Executive Council received your personal request under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP Act) for a copy of:

All studies and/or reports in the possession, custody or control of Premiere Kenney and/or his office/institution describing the **purification** (i.e. via via filtration, ultracentrifugation and chromatography) of any "COVID-19 virus" (aka "SARS-COV-2", including any alleged "variants" i.e. "B.1.1.7", "B.1.351", "P.1") directly from a sample taken from a diseased human, where the patient sample was not first combined with any other source of **genetic** material (i.e. monkey kidney cells aka Vero cells; fetal bovine serum).

Date Range: not provided.

This request excludes: duplicate records, draft records, email records which are duplicated in the final longest string, records subject to solicitor/client or litigation privilege, records containing third party business information as well as records containing third party personal information.

Your request is too broadly worded and does not provide enough detail to enable Executive Council to identify possible records. Based on the information provided to date, the request does not have sufficient detail to be considered a request under the FOIP Act. We require additional information to enable us to identify the records.

This requirement for additional details is supported by section 7 of the FOIP Act that states:

- 7(1) To obtain access to a record, a person must make a request to the public body that the person believes has custody or control of the record.
  - (2) A request must be in writing and must provide enough detail to enable to public body to identify the record.

Dear Ms. Sutherland,

In regards to your letter to me dated August 27, 2021 (attached):

You stated that "Your request is too broadly worded and does not provide enough detail to enable Executive Council to identify possible records... the request does not have sufficient detail to be considered a request under the FOIP Act. We require additional information..."

Please note that literally dozens of other Canadian institutions have had no difficulty whatsoever in responding to this same request. And, literally dozens of other institutions outside of Canada have had no difficulty in responding to this same request. Their responses are all publicly available on my website. Your responses will soon be made public here as well:

You cited section 7(1) of the Act, stating "to obtain access to a record, a person must make a request to the public body that the person believes has custody or control of the record".

Premier Kenney has claimed the existence of a new disease called "COVID-19", allegedly caused by a novel coronavirus. Therefore I have submitted my request to the public body that I believe has custody or control of the record (if it exists). No one else on the planet appears to have this record. Therefore I believe that Premier Kenney must have it, if it exists.

You stated "Executive Council has not opened a file for your request; to proceed with an access request, please resubmit your request providing enough detail, such as a specific area that would have the records..."

I do not work for the Executive Council and therefore have no idea how the Council's records are organized or what "area" would have the records. Please cite for me the provision of the Act that requires me to provide this information that I have no way of knowing, and how the public is expected to know, or discover, the "area" of Executive Council that would have specific records.

You continued: "... what type of records...."

My request reads: "All studies and/or reports..." What further detail do you require from me regarding "what type of records"?

You continued: "... defined subject matter..."




