This is a formal request for access to general records, made under the *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection* of *Privacy Act (MFIPPA)*.

- 2. prove or evidence (via ownership, contract or consent) that any man or woman has the right to block or prevent **i**, **Christine Anne of the Massey family** (a flesh and blood **woman**), or **any other man or woman**, from accessing a **public** courthouse to seek the administration of justice and move claim and court, and/or
- 3. list the **public** courthouses located in Ontario, and/or
- 4. list the privately owned courthouses located in Ontario, and/or
- 5. distinguish between public and privately owned courthouses in Ontario, and/or
- 6. define the word "public" in the context of any records provided in response to #2, #3, \$4 or #5, above.

I am in receipt of your request for information pursuant to the *Municipal Freedom of Information & Protection of Privacy Act*, received by this office from the Halton Regional Police Service Board December 8, 2021.

You have requested Any records in the possession, custody or control of Stephen J. Tanner (serving as Chief) or Roger Wilkie (serving as Deputy Chief of District Operations) or Jeff Hill (serving as Deputy Chief of Regional Operations) or Halton Regional Police Service that:

- prove or evidence (via ownership, contract or consent) that the "rules of civil procedure" (that were promulgated by a private society/corporation) apply to, or, have jurisdiction over, i, Christine Anne of the Massey family (a flesh and blood woman), or to any man, woman or child (versus "persons"/corporations), and/or
- prove or evidence (via ownership, contract or consent) that any man or woman has the right to block or prevent i, Christine Anne of the Massey family (a flesh and blood woman), or any other man or woman, from accessing a public courthouse to seek the administration of justice and move claim and court, and/or
- list the public courthouses located in Ontario, and/or
- 4. list the privately owned courthouses located in Ontario, and/or
- distinguish between public and privately owned courthouses in Ontario, and/or
- define the word "public" in the context of any records provided in response to #2, #3, \$4 or #5, above.

Please note that my request includes any record matching the above description, authored by anyone, anywhere. If any records match the above description of requested records and are currently available in the public domain, please provide enough information about each record so that I may identify and access each one with certainty (i.e. title, author(s), date, journal, where the public may access it). Please provide URLs where possible.

Pursuant to your request a search for such records was sent from FOI Coordinator, Amanda Shantz to Information and Records Manager, Shannon King. Ms. King confirmed our Service does not hold any records in regards to your request. Therefore no records exist.

A list of public courthouses located in Ontario is available through the Ministry of the Attorney General's website: https://www.attorneygeneral.jus.gov.on.ca/english/courts/Court_Addresses/. According to the Ministry of the Attorney General's webpage, the Ministry coordinates and administers court services throughout Ontario.

This office is unaware of "privately owned courthouses". As such we cannot provide or direct you to a list of privately listed courthouses listed in Ontario. Nor can we distinguish between public and privately owned courthouses in Ontario, or define the word 'public' in the context of #2, #3, #4 or #5 above.

I am responsible for this decision.

You may request a review of this decision by the Information and Privacy Commissioner, 2 Bloor Street East, Suite 1400, Toronto, Ontario M4W 1A8. Telephone 416-326-3333 or toll free 1-800-387-0073. You have 30 days to make this appeal. In the event that you wish to launch an appeal, please provide the Commissioner's office with a copy of this decision letter. In addition, you must send a \$25.00 appeal fee for general information to the Commissioner's office. Please include the fee in your letter of appeal. Appeal fees should be in the form of a cheque or money order, payable to the Minister of Finance.
