This is a formal request for access to general records, made under the Official Information Act.

Description of Requested Records:

All records in the possession, custody or control of **The University of Auckland** that scientifically proves the existence of SARS-COV-2 virus.

Scientific proof is NOT

- Opinions
- Speculation
- Review papers
- · Descriptive papers

Scientific Proof is

- · Experiments that follow the scientific method
- · Repeatable experiments that produce identical results
- · Experiments all have valid control groups

Scientific Method

The scientific method is a process used to prove or disprove hypotheses. My request requires the hypothesis to include the claim of existence of SARS-COV-2 particles. If the records do not have a hypothesis or do not have a hypothesis that claims the existence of SARS-COV-2, then these records are disqualified from my request.

Repeatability

I am requesting records that only use the scientific method and where the experiments have been repeated multiple times where the results were 100% the same. For any of the SARS-COV-2 Genome Sequences, multiple experiments must have been conducted and produced a 100% match for the SARS-COV-2 genome sequence the researchers found. Records that have not been repeated with 100% matches for the SARS-COV-2 genome are disqualified from my request.

Controls

A control experiment is an experiment that has exactly the same parameters of the experimental group sans the variable being tested. For cell culture experiments, the control group should have exactly the same composition sans the SARS-COV-2 viruses. Experiments that do not have a valid control as defined are disqualified from my request.

Summary

Please provide all records that scientifically prove the existence of SARS-COV-2 as defined in this request.

If any records match the above description of requested records and are currently available to the public elsewhere, please provide enough information about each record so that I may identify and access each one with certainty (i.e. title, author(s), date, journal, where the public may access it). Please provide URLs where possible.

Record Search

I do not expect the University to search students' computers, labs' computers, or even researchers' computers. I expect the University to direct this

request to the appropriate department who have experts in the field of virology & microbiology such as Michael Baker & Siouxsie Wiles.

I refer to your email of 19 July below, and our previous correspondence.

As you know from the University's responses to your previous requests, the documents held by the University concerning this type of research on the Covid-19 virus are publicly available library material, not "official information" under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA). As the documents requested are not "official information", the "official information" requested does not exist in documents held by the University and your request is accordingly refused under section 18(e) of the OIA. You have the right to make a complaint to an Ombudsman if you are dissatisfied with this response.

To avoid doubt, this is the University's official response to your OIA request. The OIA does not require decisions to be provided in any particular format. You are free to convert it to a pdf file if you wish.

I am making an official complaint to your response. You claimed that research on the 'Covid-19 virus' is publicly available library material, not "official information".

This is incorrect as official information is defined in the Act as any '2 (1) (a) information held' including Universities section (d).

It appears to me that you are also trying to use section 2 (1) (e) (i) of the act in order to deny future requests including this one.

library or museum material made or acquired and preserved solely for reference or exhibition purposes; or

However, the records that I have requested are for scientific proof of the existence of the alleged virus. This is for research purposes not SOLELY for reference or exhibition purposes. Also note, there is no library on this planet that contains the scientific proof using the scientific method of the existence of the alleged SARS-COV-2 virus. If you believe there is such a library, then please send me the link to their scientific papers using the scientific method that proves the existence of SARS-COV-2.

Also note, the University of Auckland has staff who claim to be experts in microbiology and virology such as Michael Baker & Siouxsie Wiles who should hold such records as applicable to my requests if such records existed (which clearly they do not).

Please rectify this error in your response by removing the erroneous statement on publicly available library material. I expect a response within 7-working days.
