

However, both sides have a separate Access to Information and Privacy offices. It can get a bit confusing, and I am aware that this is not very transparent on either of the departments' websites. In this case, we would open a new request for you on the Health Canada side to retrieve any information relevant from Health Canada, and still process your original request on the Public Health Agency side. Both requests would be processed at the same time, by the same analyst. 
