I am replying to your access request made under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the Act), for the following information:

Any records in the custody of the Ministry of Health that prove or evidence through isolation and purification the existence of viruses that cause disease as designated from Ontario's ISPA. This includes isolation and purification where a sample has been taken from a human and where no other genetic material has been added to the sample such as vero cells or bovine serum of viruses said to cause the following diseases: Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Diphtheria, Tetanus, Varicella, Pertussis, Meningococcal Men-C-C, Meningococcal Men-C-ACWY, Poliomyelitis. Also requested are records that prove or evidence the whole genome sequencing of the viruses that are said to cause the above mentioned diseases and are critical for vaccine development of said disease. These requests included records in custody of the Ministry of Health that have been authored by anyone, anywhere in the world. If such records exist please provide me links to these records so they can clearly be identified and accessed with certainty in the public domain. Please respond to request for records via email only at do not wish for anything to be sent to me via hard copy.

Time Frame: September 3, 2016 to February 26, 2023

This is to inform you that no responsive records were located. A reasonable search of the **Laboratories and Diagnostic Branch** was conducted and no responsive records were found. Patrick Dicerni, Assistant Deputy Minister, Health Programs and Delivery Division, is responsible for this decision.
